Preference will be given to children and young adults (between 10 - 20 years) with rare diseases such as blood, metabolic and neurogenetic disorders.

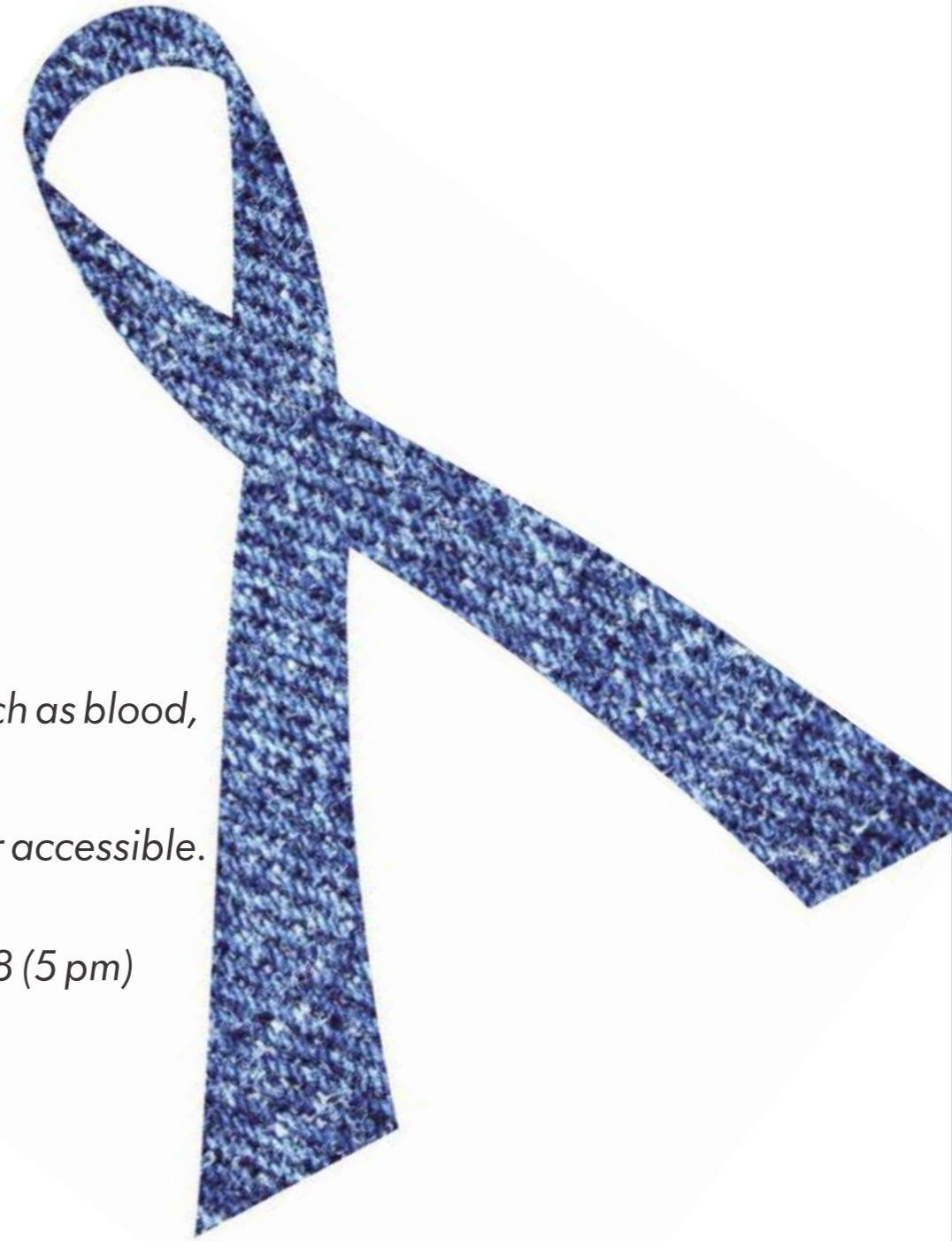
Participants with special needs must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Venue is wheelchair accessible.
